SUBJECT: PSTA Political Endorsements

The Pennsylvania Primary Election will be held on April 24, 2012 and the Pennsylvania General Election will be held on November 6, 2012. In addition to this letter you will find the PSTA "Political Endorsement Guidelines" dated March 3, 2010, a sample letter directed to a lodge president requesting an F.O.P. endorsement/support and a sample letter directed to the president of the PSTA requesting an endorsement from the Association posted on the PSTA website.

Candidates for a state-wide office (U.S. Senator, Governor, Attorney General, etc) may submit the endorsement request directly to the PSTA. Candidates seeking election to a district office (U.S. Representative, State Senate, State House, etc) must first have the endorsement/support of the Trooper F.O.P. lodge located in the political district. This procedure is discussed in the "Political Endorsement Guidelines" document.
