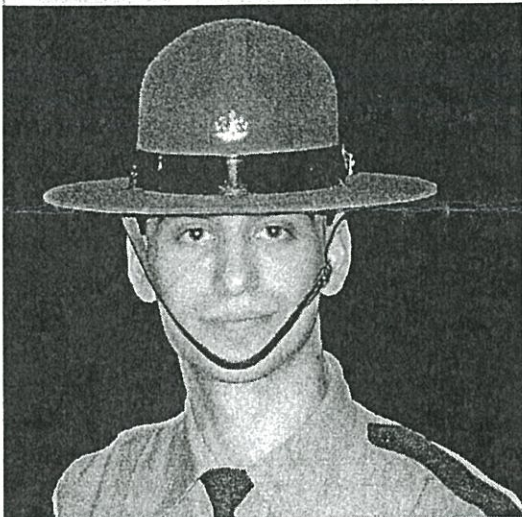


TakeOff:

Honor the Past, Shape the Future

Race and Walk in Loving Memory of Pennsylvania State Trooper Kenton E. Iwaniec
December 18, 1983 – March 28, 2008



On March 27, 2008 Pennsylvania State Trooper Kenton Iwaniec, a Westmoreland County native, finished his shift and began his drive home. Just two miles away from his station, an impaired driver crossed the centerline, hit Kenton's vehicle head-on, and another beautiful life was added to the DUI victim's death toll.

Kenton was the type of son you wanted to carry on the family name. His heart was compassionate, his mind was quick, and his sense of humor was one of a kind. Kenton was dedicated to his friends, family, God, and Country. In a few words, Kenton lived to serve.

Each year, over 10,000 families are destroyed by impaired drivers. The aftermath of Kenton's death has changed the Iwaniec family forever. In order to find meaning in his death, to honor his life, and most importantly to do anything to prevent other families from going through what they've experienced, the Iwaniecs stress the importance of responsible choices as an effective and simple way to

reduce DUIs. TakeOff is a race to honor DUI victims, raise awareness about the seriousness of impaired driving, and encourage the community to have a positive influence in the reduction of impaired driving. All profits will go to the purchase of breathalyzers (PBTs) for the Pennsylvania State Police and other law enforcement agencies throughout the Commonwealth. Since 2009, the Iwaniecs, with the help of the community, have purchased 1,800 PBTs. This year, the goal is to purchase 200 PBTs. Thank you for your support; with your help we can shape the future.
